Peer Tutoring began Tuesday, September 7, 2021. It will be for at least an hour after school in the library every Tuesday and Thursday.

Peer tutoring is a flexible, peermediated strategy that involves

students serving as academic tutors and tutees. Typically, a higher performing student is paired with a lower performing student to review critical academic or behavioral concepts.

- It is a widely-researched practice across ages, grade levels, and subject areas
- The intervention allows students to receive one-toone assistance
- Students have increased opportunities to respond in smaller groups
- It promotes academic and social development for both the tutor and tutee
- Student engagement and time on task increases
- Peer tutoring increases self-confidence and selfefficacy

Another reason peer tutoring often works better than direct instruction alone is the comfort level at which students feel with their peers, as opposed to their teachers. This also helps them to increase their social skills by working closely with other students and develops rapport between peers at school.

#### Free Meals for All Students


Thanks to the USDA, all student meals are free this year. All students are eligible for 1 lunch **and** either 1 breakfast before school or 1 brunch at brunch.

  - Do not eat, drink, or smoke within 20 minutes of the test.
  - Once all forms have been confirmed and submitted, a registered nurse will assist you with the test.
  - Tests are done with oral swab in your mouth. You will do this yourself under supervision.
