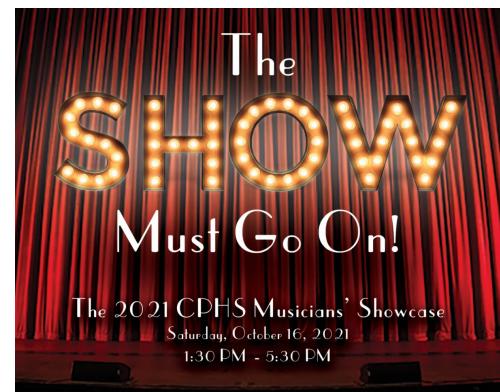

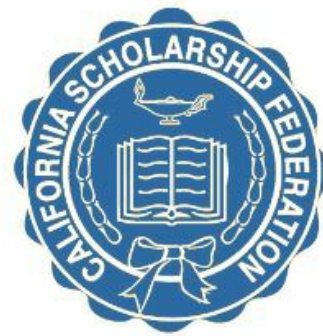


CSF Applications Accepted September 1-30
