**Date:** Friday, March 25

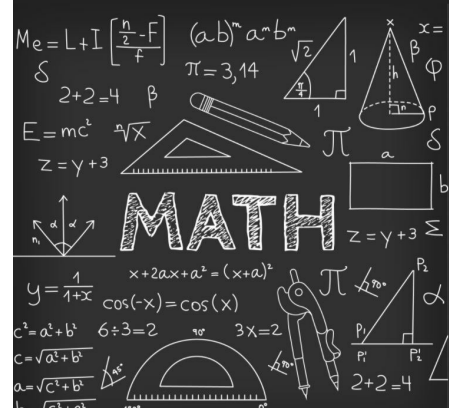
