





Eligibility Rules



Must have at least a 2.0 for 3rd quarter grades (3rd quarter ends March 18th,

2022)

- No more than 9 truancies for the year (please check your attendance, X's, U's, and B's are truancies)
- No unserved detentions or Saturday schools
- Discipline incidents after Spring Break may jeopardize your eligibility to attend

COVID Guidelines

- Masks are required for all students attending the event.
- For Vaccinated Students: Students must upload a copy of their vaccination card when they purchase their ticket online.
- For Unvaccinated Students: Students must either have a negative PCR test within 48 hours of the event or a same day @Home test that was negative prior to boarding the bus.
- Students that have initially tested positive for COVID in the prior five days will not be eligible to attend. (Full refunds will be given).
- Students that have initially tested positive for COVID in the prior ten days will be eligible if they are symptom free and have a negative test after five days.
- Students that have COVID like symptoms (fever, cough, loss of smell etc.) will not be allowed to attend the event.


The COVID guidelines are subject to change.

College Park Swim Team Showing Grit, Enduring a Winter Weather Meet

The CP swim team showed grit and courage to endure the freezing cold, artic air on Friday at Northgate during the triple dual meet against Northgate, Concord and Mount Diablo. They executed all the early season skills impeccably well. Finishing to the wall with no breath, perfecting starts, turns and streamlines with all the details that require patience. CP showed the utmost maturity in focusing on those details and not over pressuring themselves about their times. "We are early in the season; of course, we want every athlete to give their best effort, but the focus is to be a technician and perfect the mechanics that will take us to greater achievements later in the season," said head coach Vicky Dewey. CP won the meet over Concord and Mount Diablo. They proved to be competitors against Northgate.



Highlights were the girls Varsity 400 free relay of Amara Martinez, Anna Gornytski, Eva Gornytski and Elsa Horcizia with a time of 4:00.71, winning over Northgate, Concord and Mount Diablo. Also, the boys JV 400 free relay of Roke, Harper, Beridze and Gourley won with a time of 4:07.55. Soren Stanton took 2nd in the 100 breaststroke with a time of 1:03.84; Madison Branse took 2nd in the 100 fly with a time of 1:07.19; Colin So won the 500 free in 5:22.54. College Park took 2nd, 3rd, and

4th in the Girls 200 free with Anna Gornyitzki leading the group, followed closely by Horcizia and Galbraith.
