



National PTA Scholarships

Deadline: April 1, 2022

Thirty-Second District PTA awards up to six \$500.00

scholarships to high school seniors graduating from Contra Costa County high schools that participate in an active PTSA. These scholarships focus on the categories of school volunteering, community service, personal challenge, and exemplification of PTA values.



Scholarships are distributed among these areas of focus, with two awards given to students at each of these three education paths:

- career or technical school
- community college
- four-year college

High school seniors will qualify for these scholarships if they:

- are members of their high school PTSA
- are students in good standing with a minimum grade point average of 2.0
- plan to attend an accredited career or technical school, community college, or four-year college

Scholarship funds are for educational expenses such as tuition, books and supplies, fees, or special needs services.

Eligibility Rules



- Must have at least a 2.0 for 3rd quarter grades (3rd quarter ends March 18th, 2022)
- No more than 9 truancies for the year (please check your attendance, X's, U's, and B's are truancies)
- No unserved detentions or Saturday schools
- Discipline incidents after Spring Break may jeopardize your eligibility to attend

COVID Guidelines

- Masks are required for all students attending the event.
- For Vaccinated Students: Students must upload a copy of their vaccination card when they purchase their ticket online.
- For Unvaccinated Students: Students must either have a negative PCR test within 48 hours of the event or a same day @Home test that was negative prior to boarding the bus.
- Students that have initially tested positive for COVID in the prior five days will not be eligible to attend. (Full refunds will be given).
- Students that have initially tested positive for COVID in the prior ten days will be eligible if they are symptom free and have a negative test after five days.
- Students that have COVID like symptoms (fever, cough, loss of smell etc.) will not be allowed to attend the event.

The COVID guidelines are subject to change.

If you need to sign up for Saturday School, please see Ms. Thompson in Student Services North for assistance. Mr. Honey will be sending out more information in his weekly Community Newsletter.

We really hope all of you will be able to attend and enjoy one of your last activities as a College Park senior. So, please check in with your administrator or Ms.

Mahmood if you have any questions or are unsure of your eligibility status. *Do not wait until the last minute.*
