Student Work Permit Information for Summer 2022

Once a student is offered employment, a <u>work permit application</u> must be completed by the student, parent/guardian, and the student's employer. **

- Scan the work permit application or take photos of it (be sure the photos clearly have complete images of the application)
- Send images of the application by email to Mr. Hurtado.
- Please allow three-day turnaround time for processing. Your work permit will be emailed to the student when complete.
- Incomplete applications will be returned to you.
- Expiration: Student Work Permits issued in the Summer (non-school days) expire five days after the opening of the next school year (EC 49118)

**Students who reside in Mt. Diablo Unified School District boundaries but are enrolled in non-MDUSD schools:

To process a non-MDUSD student's work permit application you must include the following:

- Student's last report card
- Attendance / Enrollment of current school
