3. Page 10, Article VIII, Section 8 - to insert...

Members of the executive board may participate in and act at any meeting of the executive board via teleconferencing using equipment with which all board members participating in the meeting can communicate with each other at the same time. Participation in such meetings shall constitute attendance and presence in person at the meeting. Quorum shall be established by roll call and identification of individual executive board members.

Technology for CAASPP

In-person students will be using a district device in order to complete all testing. Students who are virtual and do not have a district device will need to download a secure browser on their device. Instructions and Videos made by the State of California to assist in downloading the browser can be found below. We will also be holding **Zoom virtual office** hours for those that might be having trouble downloading the secure browser on April 28 at 2 PM. Unfortunately, we are unable to physically help with downloading secure browsers onto personal devices.

Logging-in to CAASPP Testing

Students will need to have their state testing ID number (SSID) in order to log in. SSID numbers can be found in HomeLink in the Demographics section.

Students will also need to log in with their full first name as it appears in Aeries.



COVID testing is available for all students at College Park High School. For our athletes that participate in indoor sports (volleyball, basketball, stunt, wrestling) testing continues to be mandatory. Testing is now on

Recording of Classroom Lessons by Students, Parents or Teachers

There have been many questions regarding recordings of online sessions, so I want to share the guidelines we are following at College Park.



- Video recordings of classroom instruction qualify as "education records" under the Family Educational Rights Privacy Act, and as such are protected by state and Federal privacy laws. The following rules apply:
- Recordings by teachers of classroom instruction for distribution to students for educational purposes are permitted by FERPA. When used for an educational purpose, recordings of a classroom by a teacher are not considered an "educational record."
- Recordings by students of lessons for educational purposes are permitted but only if expressly authorized by the teacher. Under California Education Code Section 51512 it is illegal for any person including the student - to record what is happening in the classroom without the consent of the teacher.
- Recordings by parents of lessons for widespread distribution, or for virtually any use, are not permitted by the California Education Code. Again, it is illegal

for a parent to record classroom instruction without the expressed and written consent of the teacher, and such recording may not be distributed to third parties (such as in social media) under FERPA. See Ed. Code Section 51512.

- P = Present: Online synchronous instruction, 1:1 office hours
- 4 = Online Activity: Completed a test, turning in assignments, etc.
- 3 = Communication w/ Certificated Staff: 2-way communication with student and/or parent online or by email
- A = Absent (none of the above engagement)

Support Staff Code:

• 6 = Support Service Access: Speech Therapy, OT, PT, Counseling

Distance Learning Student Expectations & Protocols for Online Meetings

- Students must login using their MUDSD.Net email account
- Log-on to Zoom/Google Meet five minutes prior to class starting
- Have First and Last name correctly spelled on your Zoom/Google Meet window
- Keep cameras on (if possible) and Microphones on Mute unless speaking to teacher or as directed by teacher.
- Students should be in appropriate school attire during online meetings
