

Cell Phone/Electronic Device Policy

Students may use electronic devices and/or cell phones during non-class time. (i.e. breaks and passing periods)

Students may only use electronic devices and/or cell phones during class time when given permission by the teacher.

Students are not to use material or text messages to invade personal privacy or harass another person, or disrupt the instructional day, or engage in dishonest acts.

Please remember to be responsible! The following are inappropriate uses of electronic devices:

- ✓ Harassment
- ✓ Threats
- ✓ Intimidation
- ✓ Electronic forgery
- ✓ Cyberbullying/cyber threats
- ✓ Invasion of personal rights
- ✓ Cheating on tests/exams
- ✓ Video recording/taking pictures of illegal/inappropriate objects or acts



Students who act in violation of this policy shall be subject to the District's progressive discipline as follows:

Upon confiscation, device will be secured in the office.

1st violation – Device will be returned to the student at the end of the school day.

2nd violation – Device will be returned to the parent at the end of the school day or when parent is available to pick up.

3rd violation – Device will be returned to the parent at the end of the school day or when parent is available to pick up and the parent must meet with an administrator to discuss the student's electronic device usage at school.

4th violation – Student will be subject to suspension.

5th violation – Student will be subject to suspension and loss of school privileges.
