**IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS
GRADES 1-12
AGES 7-18 YEARS**

Mt Diablo USD uses the requirements of the California School Immunization Law, Health and Safety Code, Sections 120326-120375 and the recommendations of the Children and Adolescent immunization schedule for the US from the ACIP/CDC (Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices/Centers for Disease Control and Prevention), the AAP (American Academy of Pediatrics), and the (AAFP) American Academy of Family Practice.

VACCINE	REQUIRED DOSES	REMARKS
POLIO (IVP)	4 doses at any age	3 doses are OK if #3 was given on or after the 4 th birthday.
DTaP (diphtheria/tetanus/acellular pertussis) (or DPT/Tdap)	5 doses at any age	4 doses OK if #4 was given on or after the 4 th birthday. 3 doses OK if #3 is Tdap, given on or after the 7 th birthday.
Tdap booster	1 dose <i>for grades 7-12</i>	1 dose required on or after age 7 years
MMR (measles/mumps/Rubella)	2 doses (check dates)	1st dose must be given on or after the 1st birthday.
HEPATITIS B (HBV)	3 doses at any age	
VARICELLA (VZV) (chickenpox)	2 doses required for all new enrollees to MDUSD, and ALL students TK-10 th grade <small>(2022-23)</small> 1 dose required for existing MDUSD students advancing to grades 11-12	“History of chickenpox” box checked or doctor letter cannot waive requirement. Only official medical exemption can waive varicella requirement; apply online at https://cair.cdph.ca.gov/exemptions/home .
RECOMMENDED IMMUNIZATIONS (not required)		
COVID-19	As eligible / advised by CDC/FDA	
HEPATITIS A (HAV)	2 doses, 6 -18 mos apart, after age 1	
HPV9 (human papilloma virus)	2- or 3-dose series depending on age	
MCV4 (meningococcal conjugate virus, quadrivalent ACWY)	1- or 2-dose series depending on age
