

## **MPS:1 OPT-OUT**

As stated in the Device Liability Agreement, MPS students in grades 5<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> will be assigned a district device to use at home and at school. To decline a device, the parent/guardian must sign the Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) agreement and ensure their students' personal device meets the minimum requirements.

### **WHY OPTING OUT IS DISCOURAGED:**

Personal owned devices cannot be used for state testing.

Students who opt-out will not receive technical support of any kind for personally owned devices. It will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian & student to ensure the device is working properly and effectively every day. Failure to ensure the device is operating adequately may be viewed as though the student is not prepared for class.

### **MINIMUM DEVICE REQUIREMENTS**

**Windows 10 or Chromebook\***

**Screen Size:** 11.6"

**Wireless:** Dual Band AC 8265 (802.11ac) + Bluetooth 4.1

**Battery Life:** 14+ Hours (Approximate)

**Touch/Inking capabilities** (recommended for High School)

**\*Please note:** Depending on the class, Chromebooks at the High School level may not be adequate for the required curriculum.

### **Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) AGREEMENT**

To use a personal device, students and parents agree to the following:

The device is limited exclusively for classroom use under direct supervision. This requires the student to allow their personal device to accept a classroom monitoring program/application by their classroom teacher when requested.
