



BILINGUAL AUTHORIZATION IN SPANISH

Nearly 1 in 5 of our California public school students are English language learners, and over 42 percent speak languages other than English at home. Our students bring rich multilingual resources to school. Earning a Bilingual Authorization will prepare you to build on students' linguistic resources to support their education in two languages. Through our 5-unit certificate program, teachers can add the authorization to a Preliminary or Clear Multiple Subject, Single Subject, or Education Specialist teaching credential.

All three courses are taught online with weekly synchronous meetings.
