Geography - Our Planet

- Name and locate the four countries of United Kingdom.
- Mark the capital cities on a map of the UK.
- Recognise and compare physical features of countries in the UK.
- Recognise and compare human features of countries in the UK.
- Identify the equator and the northern and southern hemisphere.
- Locate hot and cold areas of the world.
- Discuss changes in weather and seasons from a charts.

Science- Humans, including Animals

- Notice that all animals produce offspring which grow into adults.
- Talk about simple changes in the life cycles of different animals.
- Find out about and describe the basic needs of a range of animals for survival - food, water and air.
