

### **English- The Great Kapok Tree**

To explore global issues through a narrative text, investigate how illustrations influence a reader's experience of a text, explore how an author uses language to create empathy for an issue, explore themes and debate issues and dilemmas in relation to a text, enabling children to make connections with their own lives, use sound, images and video to expand the use of ambitious and respond to and evaluate own writing and that of others.

### **Design & Technology**

This half term we will look at cooking dishes relate to the Amazon. The children will weigh out ingredients and be aware of hygiene when cooking.

### **Geography**

Our topic will centre around the rainforest. We will look at climate change, rainfall and temperature.

### **French**

The children will learn how to
