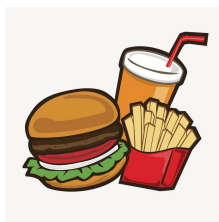

We accept and bill all insurance (commercial, Medicare, Medicaid). There is no cost to those without insurance. If your insurance does not cover the vaccine or requires a copay, the coalition will absorb that cost.

Children who participate in the clinic will be vaccinated with all CDC recommended vaccines. We will consult the state immunization registry to assess the immunization needs of each child. If you would like to refuse a specific vaccine, please contact the Indiana Immunization Coalition at least 48 hours prior to the event: clinic@vaccinateindiana.org or call 317-628-7116.

We will not initiate the COVID-19 vaccine series without explicit parental request, but we will complete the COVID-19 vaccine series if it has already been started.

11th graders- It's time for shots! This is a friendly reminder for all Juniors entering 12th grade next year, your second meningococcal (MCV4P Menactra or MCV40 Menveo) is due. This Immunization is required by the state of Indiana to enter 12th grade. MCSC can exclude students whose immunizations are not up to date. Be sure to plan ahead and get this vaccination completed at your next doctor visit. You can also visit your local clinic, pharmacy, or health department for vaccinations.
