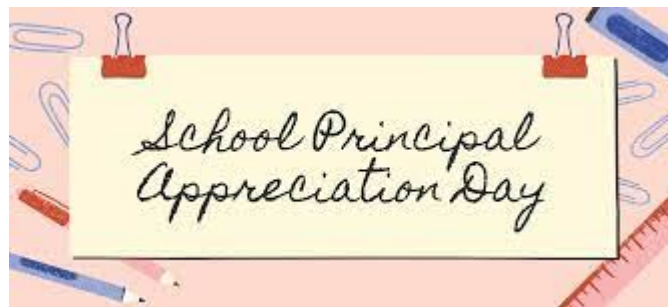

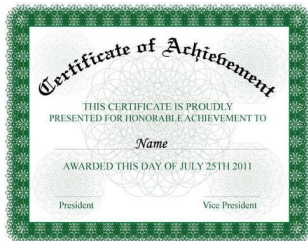
Senior Class (2023) Announcements

Award Ceremony- Seniors, the Awards Program will be held on Wed. May 24 at 7pm in the Reinhart Auditorium.

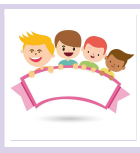

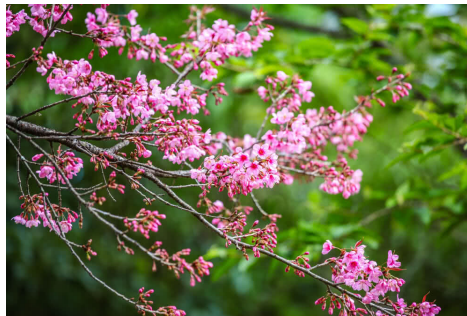

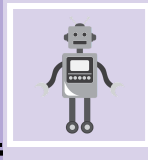
