APPR Plan Updates

In partnership with the MPTA, we reconvened our Annual Professional Performance Review Committee to revise our teacher observation and evaluation process for 22-23 and beyond to create greater flexibility, per NYS requirements.

Professional Learning Committee

The Professional Learning Committee (PLC) has begun to meet and discuss how to implement the Professional Development to Advance Teaching & Learning For All pillar from our strategic plan. Our group has representation from all four schools and our first charge is to 'Research, review and evaluate models and best practices in professional development K-12' to then embed these models for all faculty and staff.

Universal Screening

Our K-12 MTSS Core Planning Team evaluated multiple options and recommended the STAR Assessment to be our district's new universal screening and progress monitoring tool, K-12. This will replace both AimswebPlus and MAP, beginning in the 23-24 school year. Training will be scheduled soon to support our implementation. We are excited about this change and its impact on teaching and learning.
