6. What kind of animal? hunted-Adjective (**Adj**)
7. The- Article adjective (**A**)
8. After- Preposition (**P**)
9. After what? dark- Object of the preposition (**OP**)
10. Subject noun, Verb, Pattern 1, Check – SN V
