




Let's Talk! dialogues are not intended to replace face-to-face meetings or telephone calls but meant to provide an additional tool for communication.

### ✓ Security Director – oversees comprehensive district wide security plan

- Internet Protocol (IP) Cameras
- Safe Vestibule
- Safe Visitor (Check-in System)
- School Security Officer (SSO)
  - At all Middle & High Schools
  - Select Elementary
  - Available to assist all K-12, all buildings



### **SAFETY & SECURITY**

- School Resource Officers (SRO)
  - o 7 Middle Schools
  - 1 High School
- Crisis Management System (Mobile phone)
  - Plans, emergency awareness, etc.
- New Intrusion Detection System
- Summer Professional Learning for Staff on latest safety & security procedures
- Active member of the Allen County School Safety Commission

### **RESOURCE OFFICERS**




- ✓ Resource Officers work to create positive experiences for students
- ✓ When necessary, Resource Officers are allowed to make arrests



SAFETY DRILLS

- √ Required Drills
  - Fire 1/month
  - K9 Interdiction 1/semester (Middle/High Only)
  - Lockout/Lockdown 1/semester
  - Severe Weather 1/semester
  - Earthquake 1/year
  - Evacuation 1/year
- ✓ IDOE recently completed and passed a Safety Audit of required drills

### SAFETY & SECURITY: TRANSPORTATION



- ✓ Bus Cameras
- √ Bus GPS
- ✓ Monitor Bus Stops as needed
- ✓ VersaTrans Routing Software
  - Bus Stops/Student Assignments (nightly updated)
- ✓ Fort Wayne Police Department Mobile Units
- ✓ Coordinator of Student Management



### SAFETY & SECURITY: TRANSPORTATION

- ✓ Bus Driver Training (in-person & online)
  - Positive Behavior Supports
  - Annual Organizational Meeting
  - New Driver Mentor Program
- ✓ State Police Bus Inspections
  - 100% of buses pass inspection
  - Annual and Six Month Reviews





## RECENT TOPICS - BULLYING





### **DEFINITION OF BULLYING**

Indiana law defines bullying as overt, unwanted, repeated acts or gestures, including verbal or written communication.

### LET'S TALK: REPORTING BULLYING

- ✓ Bullying may be reported online via Let's Talk. (Contact Us Report Bullying)
  Reports made online are sent directly to building principals based on the school the students attend and/or the school where the bullying occurred. Parents can download the Let's Talk app and enter code FW1493 to directly access the Report Bullying portal.
- ✓ Bullying may be reported anonymously. Care should be taken to keep the identity of the child who was bullied confidential if that is his/her request, where possible. Sometimes FWCS may not be able to guarantee anonymity.





### REPORTING BULLYING

Since September, there have been 64 Let's Talk messages regarding bullying.

100% have been addressed.

## BULLYING PREVENTION PROGRAMS

FWCS conducts a number of bullying prevention programs throughout the year. These include national campaigns, middle school and high school presentations and individual programs in schools.





### **STUDENT TRAINING**



- ✓ Students receive bullying prevention training annually. The training is age appropriate, research-based instruction for all students in grades 1 through 12.
- ✓ Civilian Response to Active Shooter Training

### **STAFF TRAINING**

- ✓ All staff is required to participate in professional learning developed by FWCS regarding bullying prevention
  - District leadership completed training last summer
  - Remaining staff will complete training by the end of the school year
- ✓ Civilian Response to Active

  Shooter Training All schools

  are constantly being retrained

### TOGETHER WE DO GREAT THINGS FOR CHILDREN



- ✓ <u>Utilize Let's Talk</u> and let us know when there is a problem
- ✓ Talk to your student about bullying and encourage them to speak up to an adult
- ✓ Familiarize yourself with the resources and definitions of bullying available on the FWCS website under 'Bullying Prevention'
- ✓ Provide time for FWCS staff to conduct thorough investigation and follow up before advancing to the next level
