

Form A Notes- *Each child requires a Form A*

- 1) School year for the form (Updated Form A required each year).
- 2) Student's information.
- 3) Filler information.
- 4) Check "Yes" or "No". A copy of Immunizations or the Exemption can be emailed **if** you have never attended an ICCSD school before **and** you are coming to ICHSAP for the first time
- 5) For those joining the ICHSAP this can be submitted at a later date. This can be our [ICHSAP Education Plan \(link\)](#) which is available in a paper form, or can be filled through the Google Form you use to sign up for Supervising Teacher Meetings (available after registration).

*If you are not joining the ICHSAP, you may fill out this table, or include an outline/transcript of your planned curriculum and submit it on separate pages.

- 6) Fill in at least 148 Days, the number required under CPI. 148 represents the total instructional days/year (the number can represent combined dual enrollment, non accredited, CPI and/or home schooled instruction).
- 7) If you are joining the ICHSAP, please mark Yes, and leave the teacher information blank. Be sure to mark yes to question 11.

*If you are not joining the ICHSAP, but are working with a teacher who is licensed in Iowa, please fill in the Teacher Folder Number (License number) and contact information. All other families may leave this section blank.

- 8) Check "Yes" or "No". Check yes if your student will be dual enrolling for subjects at their attendance area school, receiving special education/IEP Services, and/or ELL.

- 9) Check “Yes” or “No” answers for a and b.
- 10) Check “Yes” or “No” for letter **a**. If “Yes”, continue through **b-c**.
 - For letter **b**, selecting “Extracurricular Activities” will allow the student to join sports, clubs, field trips and activities at your attendance area school throughout the upcoming school year.
 - To complete letter **c**, please list the subject(s), services (IEP SDI, ELL or Interventions) and/or any extracurricular activities your student will be dual enrolled in. If you chose “Extracurricular Activities”, and are not sure what your student may want to participate in, you may write “Undecided”.

*For secondary students please also add the trimester each subject will be taken.
