

Pointer/Cleaner/Caulker or PCC

Patch weathered masonry, replace old mortar and do caulking, water proofing and cleaning of both new and old masonry. They often work on swing scaffolds twenty (20) stories or more up.

Duties include but are not limited to buildings and other structures to seal them watertight, applying waterproofing of all materials, epoxy injection with pressure equipment to fractures and cracks in building to restore them to structural integrity; power washing to clean and restore buildings.

Qualifications/Requirements

- Must be 18 years or older
- Must have High School Diploma or equivalent
- Able to lift 50 lbs. Continuously
- Able to work on staging above the ground
- Have a valid driver's license
- Willing and able to attend school (2) Saturdays per month

Apprentices are part of a productive workforce. They receive paid on-the-job training along with related supplemental instruction. After each 6 month period apprentices are evaluated for wage increases provided they have completed the required on-the-job training and school hours.

Benefits

As a PCC and a union member you receive

- Medical/Dental/Vision care benefits for yourself and your dependents
- Pension Plan
- Apprentices receive pay increases at 6 month intervals

- Veterans may also qualify for VA Benefits
