## What Is A Stationary Engineer?

A Stationary Engineer is responsible for the operation and maintenance of various facilities i.e., buildings, hospitals, hotels, dairies, bakeries water/wastewater treatment facilities, correctional facilities and maintenance of H.V.A.C., Life Safety Systems, etc.

## Qualifications/Requirements

- An applicant must be 18 years of age at date of application – no maximum.
- Applicant must have a high school diploma, State Proficiency Certificate or G.E.D. equivalent.

## Benefits

## Program

Forty (40) hours per week, a minimum of 8000 hours/four (4) years of on-the-job experience. Classroom supplemental related training takes place two nights a week for 3 hours per night and 670 class hours (minimum) of related training.
