State of Wisconsin Driver Education Requirements: The student must be 14 years and 9 months old to enter the classroom. The student must be a minimum of 15 years old to obtain an Instructional Permit from the State of Wisconsin DMV. To obtain the Instructional Permit, the student MUST be enrolled for the Behind the Wheel course and show proof of passing the classroom or online course. Once a student turns 18 years old and graduates from high school, they are no longer eligible for this program.

Driver Education is a foundation course, which teaches the theory of responsible driving, defensive driving, and emphasis is placed on the introduction of the proper safety mechanics of safe driving. The course is designed to improve the student's knowledge of traffic safety and to become safe operators of motor vehicles. The course covers all areas of vehicle operation, legal obligations, maintenance, effects of alcohol and other drugs, with a strong emphasis on distracted driving.

CESA2 is assisting Monona Grove School District with the Driver Education Program. For your convenience, students may attain a Wisconsin driver's license through a program offered by CESA2. CESA2 follows all policies and procedures that are set by Monona Grove High School.

PROGRAM COST

Traditional Classroom and Zoom \$165.00- Driver Education is a foundation course which teaches the theory of responsible driving. Emphasis is placed upon introduction of mechanics of driving, execution of most driving operations, and a thorough understanding of rules of safe driving. We provide 30 hours of classroom instruction. **Not eligible for MV3001 Form for the instructional permit until successful completion of the course and enrollment for Behind the Wheel.**

We will do our best to accommodate any special needs requirements for your teen (i.e hearing impaired, IEP, diabetes, etc..). Please indicate below:

Online Course \$175.00- The Online Driver Education course offered by CESA2 provides a unique opportunity for students that have busy schedules to learn critical skills needed to become a safe, low-risk driver. Our program meets the National and State Standards for online learning. Your child will have an instructor to work with them throughout the course. Not eligible for MV3001 Form for the instructional permit until successful completion of the course and enrollment for Behind the Wheel.

Online Course Required Textbook: This course is based on the <u>How to Drive AAA 15th Edition</u>. The required textbook is NOT included with the purchase of the online course. Additional textbook information is available online at <u>www.cesa2.com</u>. To ensure you are purchasing the correct textbook, please do not order until you receive the informational email containing the link. The cost for the textbook is non-refundable.

Behind the Wheel \$285.00- This course is for students between the age of 15 and 18 who have completed the 30 hour classroom/online portion and need to fulfill the Behind the Wheel requirements for the State of Wisconsin. We will issue an MV3001 form to those students who have completed the 30 hour classroom/online portion and are enrolled for Behind the Wheel with CESA2. The Behind the Wheel course includes six hours of in car training and 6 hours of observation. Your student must successfully complete both the classroom and Behind the Wheel requirements to be eligible for the electronic DMV completion and the Wisconsin Licensing Driving Skill Test.

The Behind the Wheel training MUST start within 13 months from the end of the classroom. If this does not happen the State of Wisconsin will require the student to take a 10 hour refresher course. CESA2 offers a 10 hour refresher course or the student can retake the classroom session. There is no cost to retake the course. The online refresher course is \$75.00.

Refunds: No refunds or transfer of registration fees between students will be issued after one year from the date of the original registration. There is a \$50.00 processing fee for all refunds during the one year period. All service fees for credit card transactions are non-refundable. If your student has completed any portion of the online course, we will also withhold a portion of the registration fee for payment to the online instructor's time spent working with your student.
