Greenwood High School Athletics Retirement of Jersey Guidelines

The process for retirement of a jersey at Greenwood High School will be as follows:

- 1. Letter of recommendation for retirement of jersey candidate given to or written by Athletic Director of Greenwood High School (GHS) for approval.
- 2. Approval of candidate by Athletic Director shall be based upon the following guidelines:
 - a. Candidate *played* and *graduated* from Greenwood High School.
 - b. Candidate is at minimum five (5) years removed from high school.
 - i. Exceptions may apply at the approval of Athletic Director and Greenwood High School Principal.
- 3. Once approved by Athletic Director, the candidate shall be submitted to the Greenwood High School Hall of Fame Committee for final approval.
- 4. Approval by the Hall of Fame Committee shall be based upon one or more of the following guidelines:
 - a. All-time leading scorer for a particular sport at GHS.
 - b. Recognized as the top male or female athlete in the state of Kentucky (i.e. Mr. or Miss Basketball)
 - c. MVP of the state tournament in their sport
 - d. All-American in intercollegiate athletics
 - e. Selected to Hall of Fame of their sport in intercollegiate athletics
 - f. Played at the highest level of their sport (NBA, MLB, WNBA, etc.)
 - g. Coached a GHS team to a regional title or higher
 - h. Brought significant recognition to Greenwood High School
- 5. Jerseys of current student-athletes may be retired on an honorary basis in the event of death or other significant event during the season. Approval for this event shall be decided upon by GHS Athletic Director and Principal.
- 6. Retirement of a jersey does *not* constitute retirement of the number on the jersey.
