

Welcome to Convent High School Basketball

We are excited to welcome you to the Convent High School Basketball program.

We will have a 2 week try out period in early November and after that players who qualify will be invited to join the Varsity basketball team. The Varsity Team is open to players from all 4 grades. Selection to the team will be based on the coaches' assessment of existing skills, effort, and potential.

The Varsity Team will be practicing 5 days a week after school. Once the regular season begins in January there will be 1-2 games a week. During the season you'll be expected to attend all practices and be available for games.

During the high school season we will be focusing on developing players individually as well as getting players comfortable with organization on the court.

If there is sufficient interest we have the opportunity to run a Developmental Team where focus will be on individual athletic improvement and growth. This group will - if offered - run shorter practices 2 times a week with the possibility of playing.
