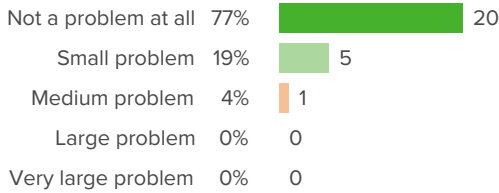

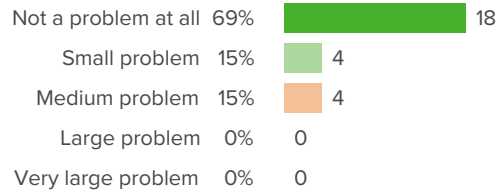


Q.5: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: You feel unsure about how to communicate with the school?



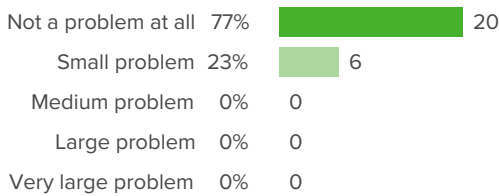

Q.6: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: The school provides little information about involvement opportunities?



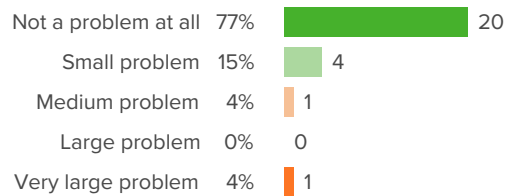

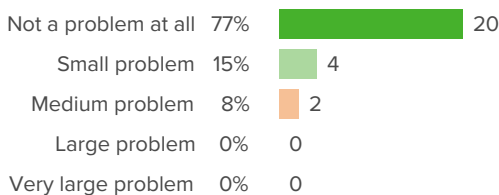

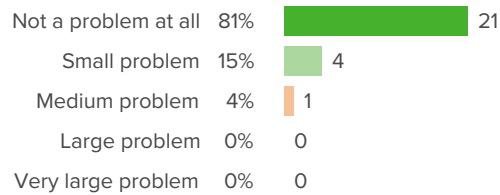

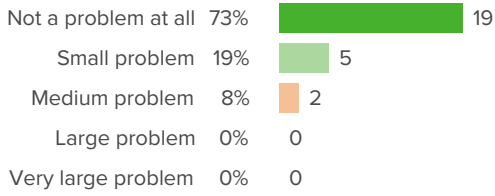
Q.10: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: Negative memories of your own school experience?

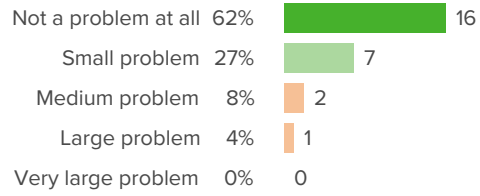


Q.11: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: Your child does not want you to contact the school?

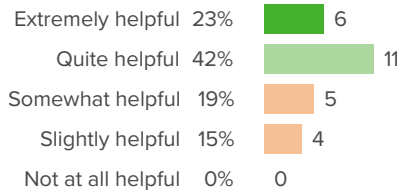

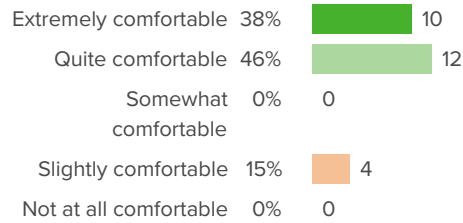

Q.1: How helpful has the communication from your child's school been this school year?



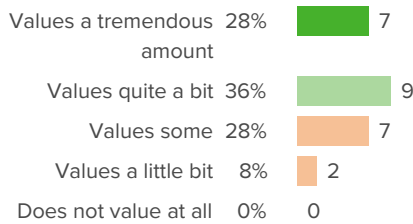

Q.2: How comfortable do you feel communicating with your child's school?



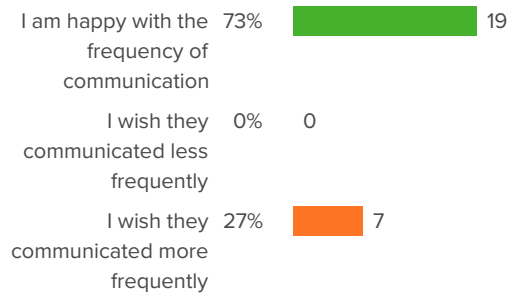

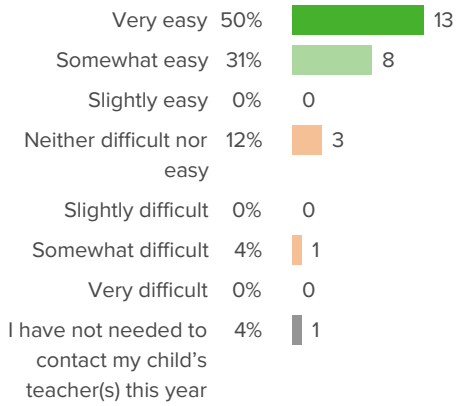
Q.4: How satisfied are you with the frequency of communication from your child's teacher(s)?

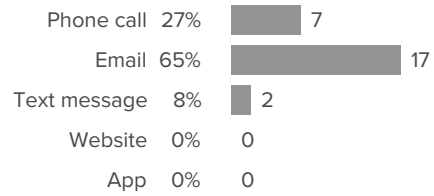


Q.5: When you need to, how difficult or easy is it to get in contact with your child’s teacher(s)?

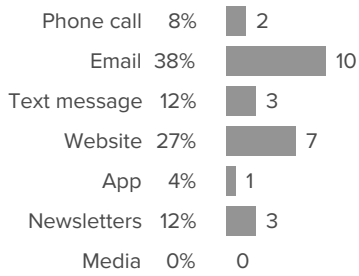

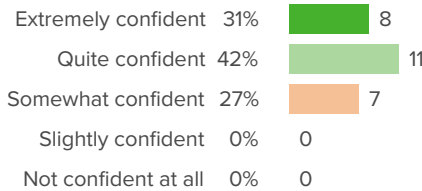

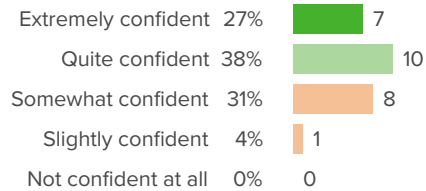

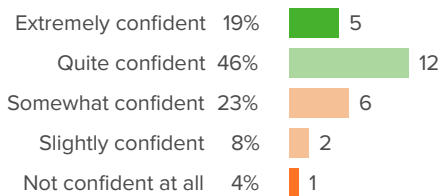

Q.2: How confident are you that you can motivate your child to try hard in school?



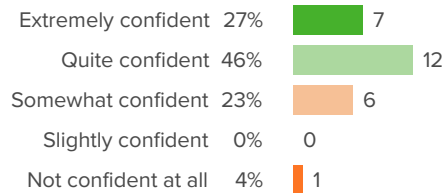

Q.3: How confident are you in your ability to make sure your child's school meets your child's learning needs?



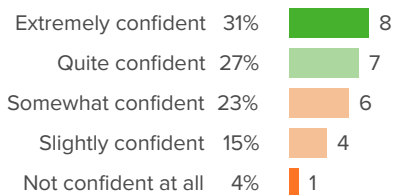

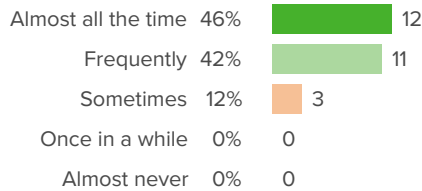

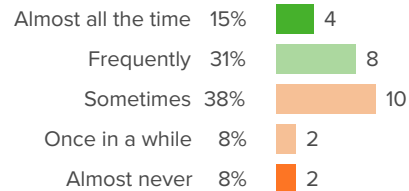

Q.1: How often do you have conversations with your child about what his/her class is learning at school?



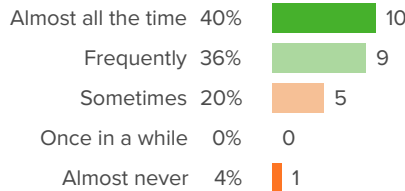

Q.2: How often do you help your child engage in activities which are educational outside the home?



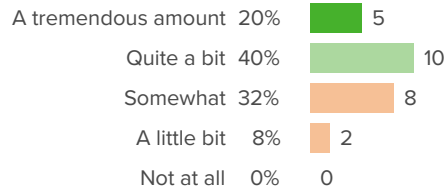

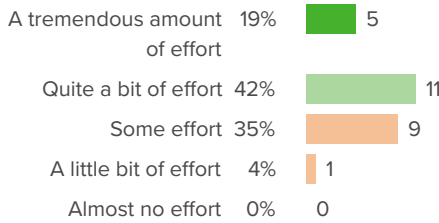

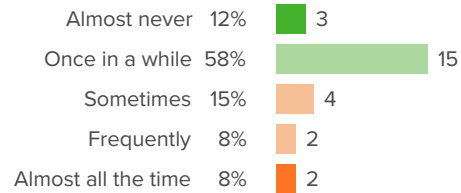

Q.1: How much effort does your child put into school-related tasks?



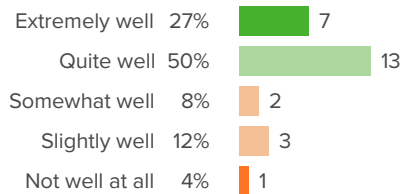

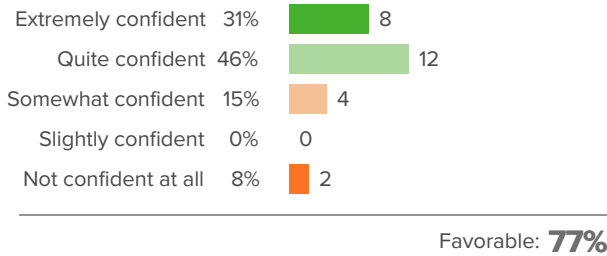

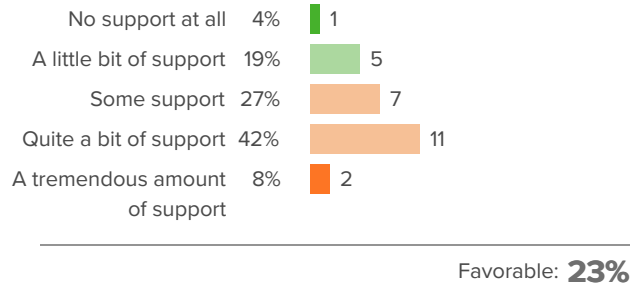

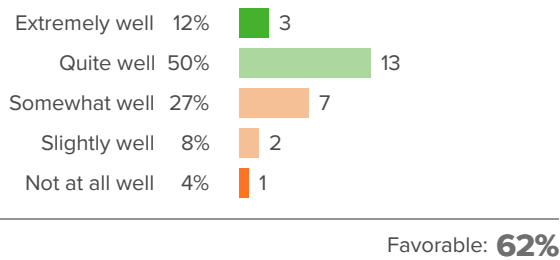

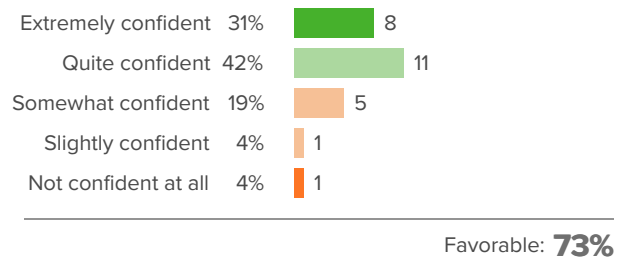
Q.2: How much support from the school does your child need to be successful when learning in person?



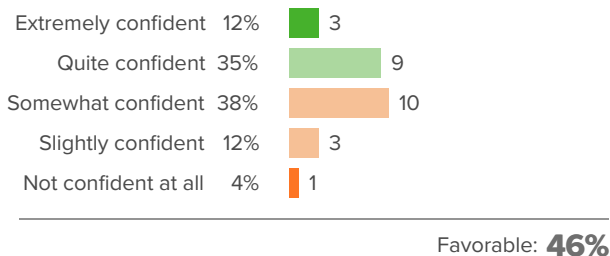
Q.3: How well do the resources at your child's school meet the needs of in-person learning?

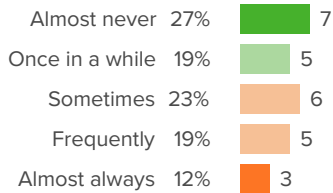

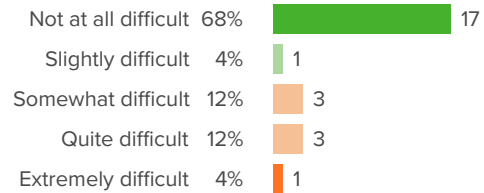

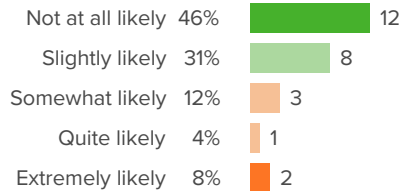

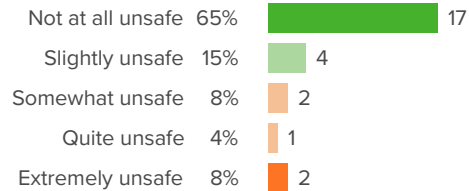

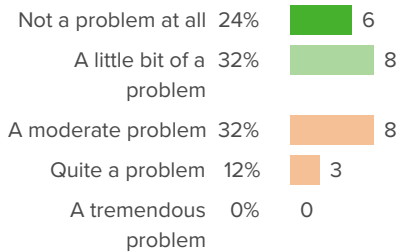

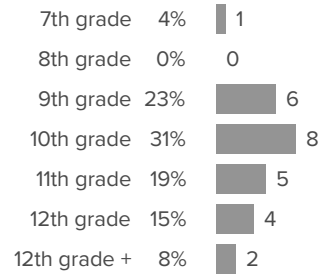

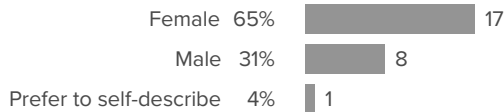
