- Student awareness

- Consolidated School Improvement Plan ("CSIP")
 - This outlines the overall goals of the school
 - Those things that are implemented in the school are tied to the CSIP goals
- Lexile Scores - - See handout
 - 195 juniors were tested
 - Data from past data of 158 juniors
 - Of the 158, 91% showed growth
 - 1/3 made double the expected Lexile gains (110 points or more growth)
- Literacy Policy
 - District initiative
 - Focus is on explicit literacy skills
 - Promotes leadership
 - It outlines our strength and areas of growth at Warren Central
 - It promotes cross curricular teaching

- District Literacy Coach meets us weekly
- This initiative is used by the cohort for this year
- The Literacy Policy was approved by consensus as a "First Reading."
- Writing Policy
 - The Writing Policy was approved by consensus as a "First Reading."
