

## **Dry Creek Joint Elementary School District COVID 19 Testing Plan**

### **Testing**

Over the Counter Antigen COVID 19 test are available at each Site and District Educational Center (DEC) for employee and student use free of charge.

- Should staff or students deem it necessary to test for COVID 19 – all district facilities have testing kits available upon request.
- Staff who have been exposed to a positive COVID case will be offered an OTC test, and asked to test within days 3-5 after exposure or sooner if symptoms appear and report results to the Human Resources Department.
- Students who test positive for COVID will communicate and report to the school attendance office.

### **Testing Supplies**

Ordering of OTC Antigen COVID 19 tests will continue through the partnership with CDPH and will be ordered as needed through the COVID 19 School Testing Task Force. Each site and the DEC will have test available throughout the 2022-2023 school year. Ordering will be done through the DEC to ensure there are the proper number of tests on hand.

### **Notification**

Should an employee test positive for COVID 19, they are to report their results as soon as possible to the Human Resources Department.

- Notification will be sent to the site staff of the positive case and individuals who were close contact will be notified directly by the supervisor and asked to test within 3-5 days of exposure.

### **Outbreaks**

Should an outbreak occur, staff will notify the Local Health Department and follow required guidelines per CDPH and the Local Health Department.
