Max Simpson Elementary

The two story configuration allows for maximized green space through a central courtyard

In partnership with Waxahachie ISD, the design team created a welcoming two-story elementary school that reflects the values of the traditional community.

Warm tones, natural textures, and geometric patterns are key design elements of the school, while the playful interior adds pops of color and fun, white wavy textured hallways to encourage student engagement and school pride. The large scale of the program is reduced through grade classroom pods, each included an easily accessible collaboration space and restrooms. Collaboration spaces for each classroom pods are used by students and faculty to support 21st century learning. Classrooms are designed for specific grade level instruction and have full height walls of marker board surfacing and an interactive projection system creating a smart wall for student learning. Wireless technology allows students to integrate netbooks and tablets into their individual and group learning in classrooms or collaborative learning spaces. The outdoor classroom is a secured courtyard providing hands on learning opportunities.








Imagine a space where children are able to learn through interactive experiences!

The Dr. Sarah K. Jandrucko Academy for Early Learners is an innovative school for pre-kindergarten children that takes learning beyond the four walls of the classroom.

The focus of the learning center is to promote literacy and numeracy development at an early age in an exploratory and engaging environment.

Centered around the research that children learn best through active, exploratory experiences, the Academy for Early Learners is structured to provide the following sixteen distinct learning experiences — typically called classrooms:

Navigation - Let's Get Going; Space; Wonderland; Journey in Time

Investigation - Wonderful, Amazing Me; My Greenhouse; Pet Central; The Zoo


Exploration - Tropics; Ocean; Savanna; Polar



Design in harmony with the physical environment, conscious of the immediate surroundings, energy use, and sustainability

This school prepares students to enter the professional workplace. The classroom wings "spin off" a central four-story atrium, where all the schools can mix. Small, informal break out spaces provide marker boards and projectors outside the classrooms.

The physical environment dictated many features of the design. Pre-cast panels on the south and west sides of the building buffer highway noise for occupants and provide thermal mass on those exposures. The building is conditioned using a geothermal HVAC system. The north and east sides open up with more windows, bringing in natural light to occupants.

Cleburne High School Career and Technology Education

Revitalizing a historic high school to respond to modern curriculum.

Drawing inspiration from the town's original high school built in 1918, the school showcases a traditional exterior coupled with a state-of-the-art interior. This iconic building underwent renovations for the first time in 40 years. Accommodating 2,500 students, each wing includes collaboration and breakout spaces.



More than accommodating rapid growth, the comprehensive renovations and additions to the high school became an opportunity to enrich and reinforce the community's culture, advance their educational model, and equip students for their future success. Years of reactive facility improvements led to a disjointed campus that was difficult to navigate and unequipped for next generation learning. The new design provides space for collaboration and ideation to facilitate new education models while industry-aligned CTE facilities provide new pathways for success.

The design encompasses traditional, alternative, and career technology spaces in a single campus. Tapping into community needs, the expanded CTE curriculum provides career pathways prior to graduation. Programs, which were informed by the surrounding community needs, included: auto collision repair; architecture and construction; engineering; sports and entertainment; marketing; welding; advanced graphic design; animation; AV production; culinary arts; telecommunications and networking; cosmetology; education; criminal justice; health science; and veterinary science.

By utilizing virtual reality, the community could truly become a part of the design process, viewing the design in a more tangible way, which helped further the goals of the project.
