Qualifications of Board Candidates

A qualified candidate shall be defined as a person who is:

- a registered voter in the Joshua Independent School District.
- a resident in the Joshua Independent School District for six (6) months and a resident of the State of Texas for twelve (12) months prior to the filing deadline for election.
- 18 years of age (or older) on the first day of the term to be filled at the election.
- a person who meets all other requirements as provided by law stated in Texas Election Laws: Election Code: Subchapter A: Eligibility Requirements for Public Office: Section 141.001; Texas Education Code 11.066.

Election Information

Applications for a place on the ballot can be obtained at the Joshua ISD Administration Building, 310 E. 18th Street, Joshua, Texas 76058. Applications are available for pick up during normal business hours. Monday thru Thursday 8:00 am – 4:30 pm and Friday 8:00 am – 4:00 pm.

Important Election Dates

- **January 18, 2023:** First day to file an application for a place on the ballot
- **February 17, 2023: 5:00 PM** Deadline for filing for place on General Election Ballot
- **April 6, 2023:** Last day to register to vote to be eligible for election
- **April 24 – May 2, 2023:** Early voting by personal appearance. (See below)
- **May 6, 2023** Election Day from 7:00 am – 7:00 pm
