He has been at Texas Tech for 35 years, and holds the title of Professor of Meat Science. He has coached many national champion meat judging teams and has been awarded Outstanding Researcher and Outstanding Teacher by the American Society of Animal Science. Additionally, he was selected as one of the Top 40 Professionals in America. Dr. Miller has received more than \$36 million in research funding and has had hundreds of research papers published. Dr. Miller is not only dedicated to his work, but also to helping others. He helped build 25 homes in Nuevo Progreso, Mexico as a mission to serve the homeless, and became an ordained minister in March, 2015.
