He is the co-director of The Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Fellowship in Fort Worth, Texas. Dr. Smith has been voted by his peers as a Fort Worth, Texas, Top Doctor from 2005 – 2019. Dr. Smith visits Guatemala and Nicaragua twice a year to operate on children with congenital and acquired deformities and has conservatively performed over 1100 successful operations on children and adults in need.
