

Joshua High School 1981 Volleyball Team



The Joshua High School 1981 Volleyball Team was only the second team in Joshua High School history to reach the regional tournament in its specific sport history. These ladies won the District Championship with an overall record of 10-2. They captured the Bi-District Championship by defeating Commerce 13-15, 18-16, and 15-7 in a best of three sets in a match. These ladies then traveled to Texas Woman's University in Denton for the regional tournament. There they competed extremely

hard only to lose a very well fought best of three sets in a match versus Linden-Kildare. Their head coach, Glenda Miller, shared this reflection about her team: “The LADY OWLS 1981 Volleyball team was a dream come true for a coach. When the season started I don’t think any of us had any idea where it would go. The credit for this season goes to a group of young ladies who worked incredibly hard both physically and mentally, were willing to learn defenses and offenses that were totally new and really, really different from what they had done in the past and then to put in the practice time to be successful. These girls believed in themselves as a team and never gave up on any game. This team won Bi-District by coming from behind in the last game of the match and won games and respect of the teams at Regionals. When I think of this team, there are many, many stories I could tell, but the one thing I have to say about them is that they were FUN and they had FUN!”.
