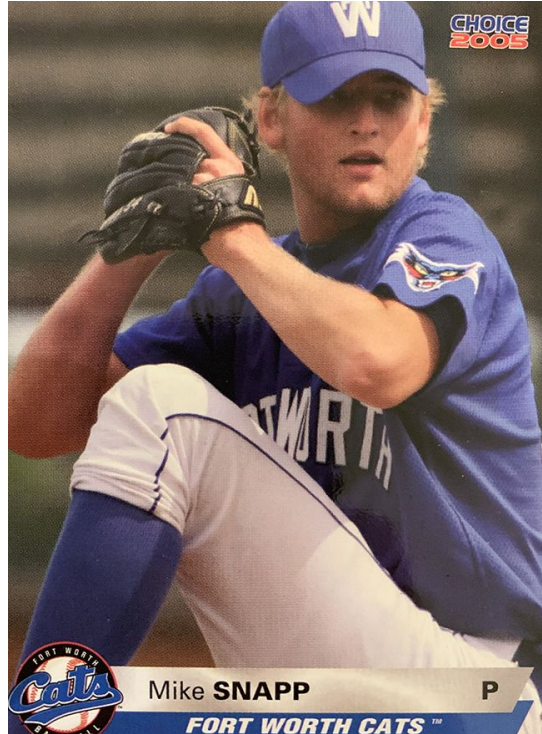
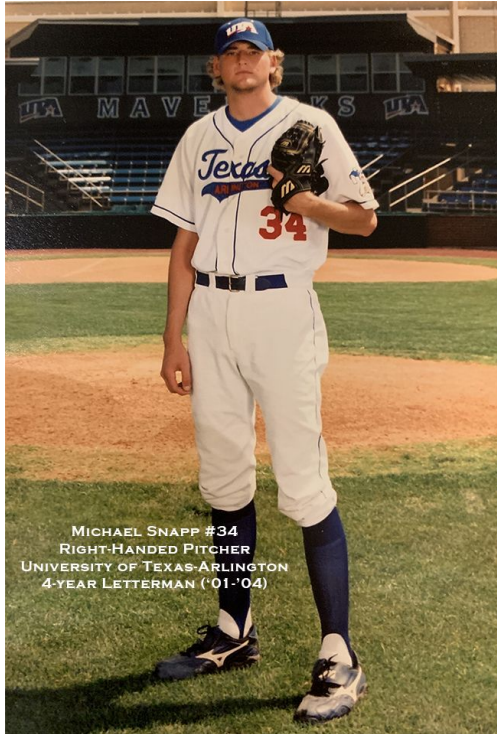


## Michael Snapp
