### **SHAC Minutes**

1. Welcome

2. SHAC Overview & Purpose
  - a. Election of Co-Chair **introductions were made around the room and April Garvin was elected co-chair of the SHAC.**
3. District Nursing Department Update Ms. Tasha Estes provided the nursing update to the committee. Dr. Martin commented on the SchoolMed programming that was introduced to the committee via the powerpoint presentation and appreciated the plan for this program to help eliminate the spread of various viruses on our campuses.
4. Child Nutrition Department Update: **Mrs Kari Frederick provided the following update**
  - a. Participation back to pre pandemic levels (down about 14 percent from last year).
  - b. Fear Factor was held at all Elementary campuses in October; kids are beginning to anticipate this event each year. This year we did tomato juice, olives, okra, hominy, and cranberry sauce.
  - c. Secondary food sculpture contest was done at the secondary campuses in November and we saw greater participation this year.
  - d. Supply chain issues have still not subsided. Food costs up approximately 22 percent. **The district has received some grant monies from Supply Chain Grants and the PEBT will continue for the families who qualify.**
  - e. Using \$100,000 in excess fund balance to replace old equipment.
5. Counseling Services Update Mrs. Burge asked if the counseling department at the high school had considered an After-Prom event for 2023. Mrs. Shafer was going to contact the JHS Counseling Department with that question. Mrs. Shafter provided the following for the update: any after prom event is held by parents and there hasn't been much interest in parents putting together something for after prom. Secondly, they have been able to get anyone to coordinate shattered dreams in recent years. They also believe there is a cost associated with this program.
