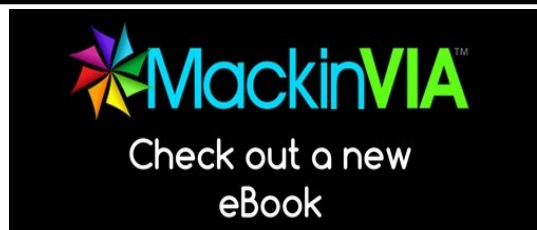




eBook Access Instructions
