Students Considering **House Bill 1758**

Washington State House Bill (SHB) 1758

Community or Technical College - Issuance of High School Diploma or Certificate



A community or technical college may issue a high school diploma or certificate as provided under this section:

(2) An individual enrolled through the option established under RCW 28A.600.310 through 28A.600.400 who satisfactorily completes an associate degree, including an associate of arts degree, associate of science degree, associate of technology degree, or associate in applied science degree, shall be awarded a diploma from the college upon written request from the student.

Students wishing to pursue the option of obtaining their high school diploma through the college must meet with their counselor and complete the documents needed by the Puyallup School District.

SHB 1758 – Impact on local scholarships and graduation:

A student pursuing the SHB 1758 diploma will not be eligible for the district's local scholarship program and will not be able to participate in his/her high school graduation ceremony.
