An academic team from Paul Laurence Dunbar High School earned the No. 1 spot in state and national rankings after the fall's 3-2-1 Quiz Bowl.



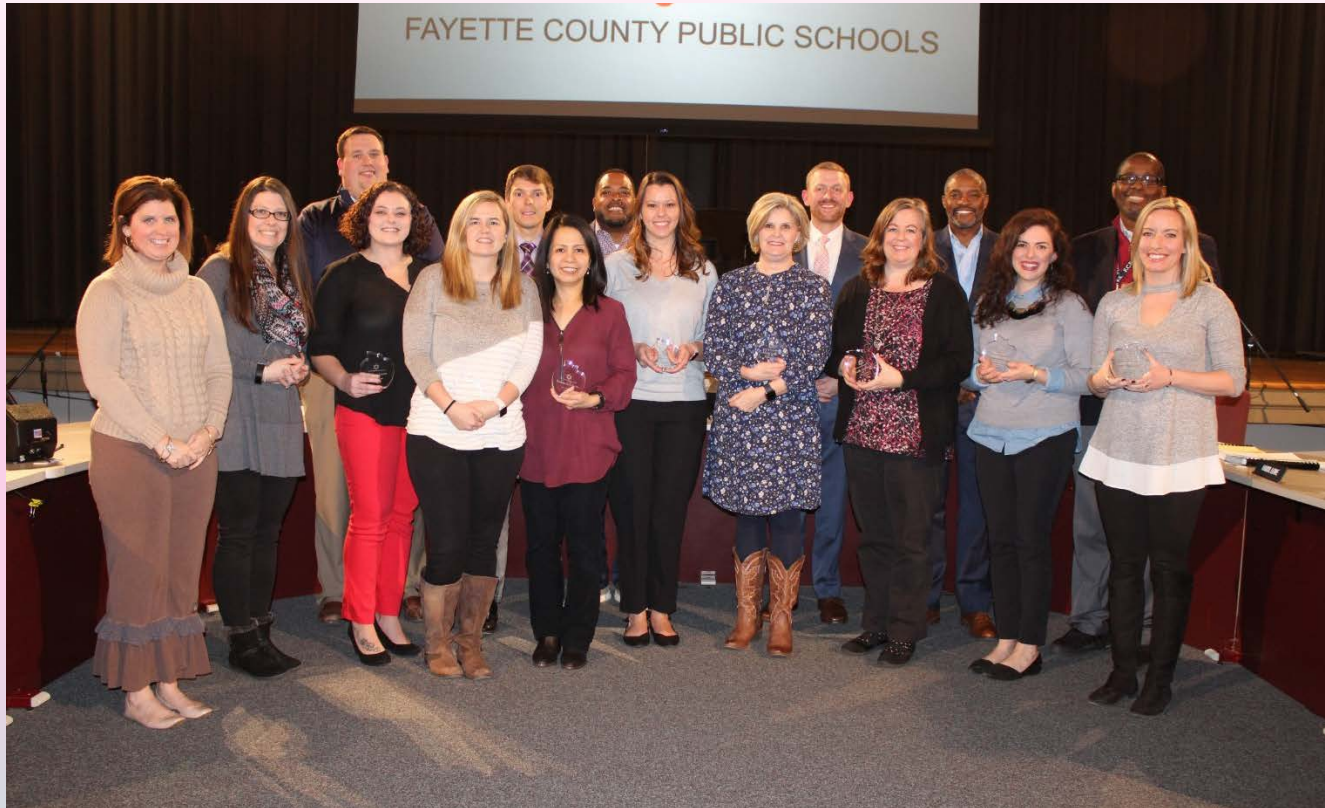
