

***Public Comment:**

Members of the public may address the Equity Council Committee during the period set aside by the Equity Council without submitting an item for the agenda. No action shall be taken during this portion of the meeting on issues raised by employees or the public unless deemed an emergency by the Equity Council Committee.

Please note: Speakers will not be allowed to make any disparaging or critical remarks about individuals or employees of the District. Critical comments or complaints are processed through the District's complaint procedures, which afford the individuals to whom comments, or complaints are directed the opportunity for response and due process.

a. There is one opportunity for the public to address the Equity Council Committee:

At the end of the meeting, members of the public, who have signed-up prior to the meeting, are invited to address the Equity Council Committee on any topic of District-related concern. It is important to know that this is not intended to be a time where issues will be debated. The Equity Council Committee will take the public's input into consideration and properly redirect the input via the Equity Council Liaison.

Each speaker will be allowed a maximum of 3 minutes.
