

## Employability vs Academic Grading System Explained:

### Academic Grades Will:

consistently communicate what a student knows, understands, and/or can do (related to academic achievement) to students and their families.

### Employability Grades Will:

Consistently demonstrate what a student knows, understands, and/or can do (related to employability) in the areas of dependability, communication, and technology to students and their families.

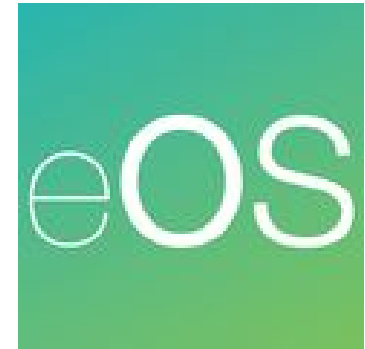
**An average score of at least 90% is needed for most:**

- School wide reward participation
- School dances

## Key Vocabulary

<b>Employability</b>	Schoolwide expectations that are tracked for each student in every class. The three areas at BSHS are dependability, communication, and technology.
<b>Focus Taps</b>	Positive and negative observations for any student, at any time. Taps are used for documentation and to keep behavior information flowing.
<b>ePass</b>	Digital hall pass system. Records the time a student leaves the classroom and the time a student returns to the classroom.
<b>eOS</b>	Employability Operating System
<b>eOS Average</b>	The average percentage when the scores from all the student's classes are averaged together.

## How can I check my student's score?

Parents must verify their email with Infinite Campus to login and follow their student.

1. Visit <https://eos.fcps.net>
2. Click "Parent Register"
3. Fill out the form and make sure the email matches what is on record in Infinite Campus. (Parents can change their email in Infinite Campus using the Parent Portal.)
4. An email will be sent to complete the registration/verification process (***the link in the email will expire in 1 hour!***)
5. Click on the link in the email and you will be directed to create a password.
6. You may now login.

## Grading Students' Employability: eOS Explained

We utilize the Employability Operating System (eOS) to assess students' employability in the five areas of being positive, respectful, showing integrity, dedication, and excellence at school each day. Students earn all their points at the start of class and lose points by not meeting behavioral expectations. Students can login and see their eOS scores at any time by visiting <http://eos.fcps.net>, using their school email and password.

Throughout the school year, students will earn rewards based on their eOS scores. Low scores can result in the loss of opportunities to participate in these rewards, in addition to after school events (i.e. school dances.)

Common Examples:

Late to class = loss of point that day

Using a cell phone in red zone = loss of point that day
