Supplemental Positions – Second Reading

Final revisions were made to Supplemental Positions, Mrs. Manley made motion to approve, Josh Mounts seconded; unanimous.

Staffing Allocations

Mrs. Heise presented the staffing allocations for next school year. The staffing allocation presented removed .5 French position, one health/PE position and one math position in order to meet the reductions from IAKSS. Mrs. Heise plans on submitting a proposal to the board for two additional staff positions for the 2006-07 school year, but until it is approved, the council had to accept or reject the current proposal.

The council discussed scheduling options in relation to staffing. Mr. Hoskins recommended that to maximize our staff, the reading specialist and curriculum coach positions should teach some classes during the day. The council discussed the possibility of those positions teaching the exploratory block to help reduce the number of students in exploratory classes.

Mr. Hoskins motioned to accept the current staffing allocation from Mrs. Heise and Mr. Mounts seconded; unanimous.
