- I. **Call to order:** Mr. Hoskins called the meeting to order 4:45 PM.

- VI. **Good News Report:** The BETA Club was named a School of Distinction by the national BETA Club group. Band, orchestra, and chorus all received distinguished scores at the KMEA assessments. Michelle Areaux, seventh grade language arts teacher, has signed a book publishing deal. She will have her first novel available at Barnes and Noble, Amazon, and Joseph Beth Booksellers. April Deener, eighth grade social studies teacher, has been named a Kentucky representative for the Common Assignment Study with the Gates Foundation. Lacrosse won their first ever district championship. The following students placed first in the district track championships: Jhnaya Chenault in 400 meter dash, DeAndre Tresvant in long jump. The boys finished third and the girls finished fourth overall. Sammy Hall, sixth grade math teacher, won the Tell on Your Teacher Tuesday Award after being nominated by one of his students. Lois Wiggins, band director, has been nominated for a Music Educator Award by the Grammy Foundation.
