- I. **Call to order:** Mr. Hoskins called the meeting to order at 5:02 PM.
- II. **Reading of Mission Statement:** The council read the mission statement.
- III. **Agenda Approval:** Mrs. Biddle motioned to approve the agenda as amended. Mr. Finnell seconded. Unanimous decision.
- IV. **Previous Meeting's Minutes:** Mrs. Anderson motioned to approve the minutes. Mrs. Davis seconded. Unanimous decision.
- V. **Public Address:** No one wished to address the council.
- VI. **Good News Report:** The golf team finished first overall in the Tri-State Middle and High School World of Golf 18-hole tournament in October. Boys' cross country placed second in the state meet. Tripp Walker was named to All-State Cross Country. Tripp Walker All Area and All State. Montae Ashford and Kanaan thomas were All Area Honorable Mention. Eden Anderson and Ava Wilson were All Area. Fern Frost was elementary All Area. Coach Tim Poindexter was named Area Six Coach of the Year. The girls' cross country team placed eighth. 7th grade Kate Baker was named honorable mention on the all state middle school girls' basketball team. Nathan Miracle and Jasmine Barnes placed sixth in the food products and processing division at the FFA National Convention. Ann Fraley and Acie Newland placed fourth in the environmental services division at the FFA National Convention. Cheerleading received national bids in both the 2.5 minute routine and the Game Day routine. In addition, they won the KAPOS regional competition for the sixth consecutive year. Both JV and varsity football won the district play off championships, as well as the regular season championships. Varsity completed their sixth consecutive undefeated regular season and fourth consecutive play-off championship. Alivia Rhodes, Paisley Sproul, and Amerah Sweatt were named to the All-State Choir. Sixth grade girls' basketball won the district tournament on December 6. The JV girls' basketball team won the regular season championship.
- VII. **Committee Reports:** The council was provided November meeting minutes for the following committees: GT/ALP, School Improvement Plan, Pre-Academy, Mission and Vision, MTSS Behavior, MTSS Reading, MTSS Math, Kagan Coaches, Character education, Foundations- Students, Foundations- Staff, and Public relations.

extend usage of No Red Ink through the 2021 school year, we the option to use activity funds in August to extend usage through the 2023 school year. Mrs. Snodgrass motioned to approve the plan. Mrs. Biddle seconded. Unanimous decision.

- a. Mr. Hoskins presented the Second Steps social emotional learning curriculum the district will provide to the school, pending council approval. The curriculum would be implemented at all three grade levels beginning in the 2020-2021 school year. Ms. Nall motioned to adopt Second Steps. Mrs. Snodgrass seconded. Unanimous decision.
- b. Ms. Bramel presented the national dance and cheer competition trip. Mrs. Nall motioned to approve. Mrs. Snodgrass seconded. Unanimous decision.
- c. Mr. Hoskins presented the IdeaFest field trip for February 1, 2019. Mrs. Biddle motioned to approve. Mr. Finnell seconded. Unanimous decision.
