- VI. **Good News Report:** The speech and debate team performed well in their first outing at the KESDA competition. Priti Bhandari was the top 6th grader in storytelling. Madison Lambert and Katie Beth Boatman were semi-finalists in impromptu speaking. Chloe Breeze and Jocelyn Davenport were semi-finalists in impromptu speaking pairs. Chloe Breeze placed first in the ad simulation, which was a new category this year. Siddarth Sundar and Emily Hall both placed third in their respective divisions at the Regional Science and Engineering Fair. Sundar also received a special recognition award from the Air Force as his project focused on helicopters. Carson Morris earned a silver medal in the 2020 Scholastic Art and Writing Awards for an essay he wrote during his first quarter GT class. This comes with national recognition. Thomas Epps and Emily Hall advanced to the state level with their National History Day essays and projects. The WEB coordinators placed signs in all of the current WEB leaders thanking them for their contributions this school year.
