





## Community Service Resources

In order to receive elective credit for community service students must abide by district policy:

1. Perform work for a non-profit organization
2. Complete the work for neither money nor credit
3. List hours worked on a daily basis as performed (do not log as total sum of hours worked over an extended period of time)
4. Have the adult that supervised you sign for your work completed each day (Adult may not be family member)
5. Perform work outside of regular school hours
6. Submit completed form to the Counseling Office
