

ADMINISTRATION IN POLICY ABSENCE

In the absence of established school board policy or school board direction, the superintendent of schools shall assume responsibility for whatever decision or action is taken. Except in unusual emergency situations, principals, or their designee, shall gain the approval of the superintendent before taking any action.

In the situations that arise within the schools where the board has provided no guides for administrative action, the superintendent shall have power to act, but their decisions shall be subject to review and ratification by action of the Board at its regular meeting. It shall be the duty of the superintendent to inform the Chair or Vice-Chair of the Board promptly of such action and, if desirable, of the need for policy.
