

**2023-2024 HENRY CLAY HIGH SCHOOL SCHEDULING
INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS for the CLASS OF 2024
Current 11th Graders moving to the 12th Grade in 2023-2024**

You will find graduation requirements, course listings with descriptions, and other important information in the Program of Studies on the Henry Clay Counselor Scheduling website. All applications for many different programs and course are listed on the website, as well. Please make sure you submit your applications and documents by the deadlines.

All students must complete their schedules on the Subject Choice Card and be ready to meet with their counselor on the following dates during their English class. If you are taking English at a technical center, your counselor will arrange a time to meet with you between January 25 and February 1.

Two of your classes will be the core courses (English and Math). Four of your courses will either be electives and/or classes you need for graduation. See the Henry Clay Graduation Planner/Worksheet on the website if you are not sure what you need to graduate. You can view your transcript on your IC portal.

CORE COURES: Your English and Math teachers will be making recommendations for you. Please talk with them to make sure you are properly placed in English and Math. You can discuss the recommendations and options at your meeting with your counselor.

SELECTING YOUR ELECTIVES: You need to select at least 4 electives even if you are wanting to do Work Study, Co-op, EBCE, or any other course/program that allows you to leave school. Every student must have a total of 6 courses entered. You will be submitting your applications for these other programs and acceptance confirmation is not complete until after scheduling is over so everyone MUST select at least 6 courses total. The pre-college curriculum requires two years (levels) of the same world language. If you take the 2nd level, this is considered as having the two years required. If you are not taking a World Language, we recommend that you continue a pathway.

TECHNICAL CENTERS ~ Eastside and Southside: These programs and pathways are described in the Program of Studies. If you choose to attend a technical center, you will spend ½ of each day at the technical center and ½ of each day at Henry Clay. Bus transportation is provided between Henry Clay and the technical centers. An application is required and is available online. However, you may also be required to choose one of your core classes at the technical centers as listed on the Subject Choice Card. Information and the application link is on the Henry Clay Scheduling website.

COURSES/PROGRAMS REQUIRING AN APPLICATION – See the Program of Studies for complete descriptions:

Eastside Southside Work Study EBCE BUSINESS CO-OP HENRY CLAY “U”

If you apply to Eastside, Southside, EBCE, or Henry Clay “U”, you must complete your subject choice card as if you are attending Henry Clay for a full day (6 classes). You will submit your application for these programs online. The Application link is available on the Henry Clay scheduling website. Once you are accepted, your high school counselor will contact you to adjust and finalize your 2023-2024 schedule at Henry Clay. You may also take one of your core classes at the technical center based on offerings listed on the Subject Choice Card and based on your graduation requirements.

HEALTH AND PE: 9th grade Fitness does not count toward the Health and PE requirement. Taking Health and PE during the summer is not required and it does require a fee for each. If you are taking Health and PE during the summer, you will need to discuss this with your counselor during your scheduling meeting. The past cost of summer Health and PE was \$160 for PE and \$125 for Health. Reduced lunch students paid \$100 for PE and \$80 for Health. Free lunch students paid \$75 for PE and \$60 for Health. These fees may change, but we will notify you before registration if there are changes. **Make sure you complete the online form on the scheduling webpage to receive information about registration.**
