If students do not take 2 years of an art, music, or theater class, they will need to take the online Arts and Humanities class during their sophomore AND junior years. This will be assigned at the beginning of those school years.

***Students are encouraged to fulfill the pre-college curriculum by successfully completing through level 2 of a World Language. Some elite college require completion through level 3. Check the college admission requirements when making a decision.
