MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

THE BOWLING GREEN CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION

AND THE BOWLING GREEN EDUCATION ASSOCIATION, INC.

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") between the Bowling Green City School District Board of Education (the "District") and the Bowling Green Education Association, Inc. ("BGEA") is regarding supplemental contracts.
