I understand that I will register before October 4, 2022 and no later than November 15, 2022 pending extenuating circumstances at the discretion of the West Mesa administration. (For AP Government & Economics I will need to be registered by January 20, 2023)

Credit & Fee Agreement for 2022-2023' Advanced Placement

I understand that I am not guaranteed college credit upon completion of the course and exam, but colleges will use my exam score to determine if I gain credit or not. I agree to pay the \$3 per exam fee. I'm paying \$3 per exam due to qualifying for free and reduced lunch at West Mesa High School. If I choose to not take the exam fee, I will incur a \$40 fee to be charged to my StudentVUE account.

Your student has the opportunity to take College Board Advanced Placement (AP) exams in May 2023. The initial cost of each exam is \$94; however, many low income New Mexico students may qualify for test fee reductions.

The Census "poverty threshold" varies by family size and the ages of family members, but it is not adjusted for differences in the cost of living, including the higher costs of living in Alaska and Hawaii. If your school chooses to use the Census Bureau's "poverty threshold" to determine a student's low income status and eligibility it should use the 2011 "poverty threshold" information available at the U.S. Census Bureau website:

2. The student's family receives assistance under Part A of Title IV of the Social Security Act.
3. The student is eligible to receive medical assistance under the Medicaid program under title XIX of the Social Security Act.
