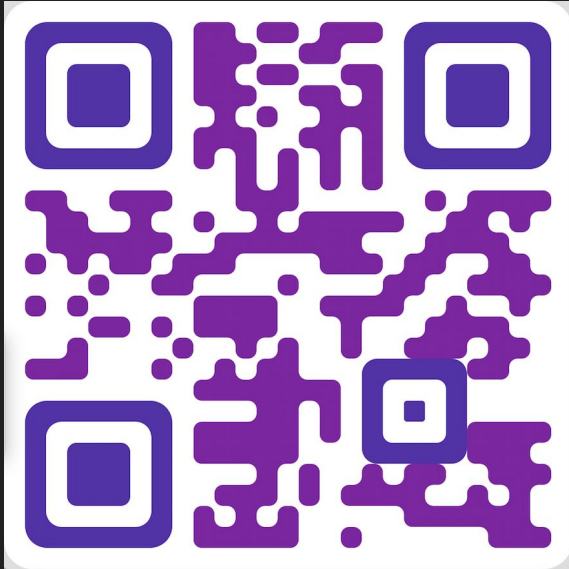
Accessing Transcript on Student VUE

College Applications

- Now, you can just fill out the application and fees will be waived and transcripts can be sent later. Some schools require ACT/SAT Scores, Letter of Recommendations, Essays, Resume, Cover Letter, etc...Look for what they are requiring for admissions! Most schools have become “test optional for this application year! But it never hurts to take an SAT for scholarship opportunities!
 - UNM Priority Deadline is February 1, 2023!
 - NMSU, ENMU, NMHU, WNMU, etc...priority deadline is March 1, 2023
 - For the majority of universities filling out your application earlier only benefits you because you can meet some of the deadlines for scholarships that pass in the spring time!
